

# Donning Standard Operating Procedure: COVID-19 Enhanced Droplet & Contact Precaution

## PRIOR TO START:

1. Hydrate
2. Use the restroom
3. Check that all donning equipment is available
4. Wash your hands

**NOTE: All PPE will be stored in isolation cart outside the patient room. Don all PPE prior to entering the patient room.**

<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Verify you have all PPE & Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collect all supplies</li> <li>• Hydrate</li> <li>• Go to the Restroom</li> <li>• Tie Hair out of the way</li> <li>• Check for any PPE integrity issues</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Perform hand hygiene	
<input type="checkbox"/>	3	Don isolation gown*  <i>*If direct patient contact is not anticipated and not cleaning room, gown is not required</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that the gown fits appropriately and is secured at neck and waist</li> <li>• Gown should fully cover body from neck to knees, your arms until the end of your wrists and wrap around the back</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	4	Don facemask	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that the mask effectively covers you're your nose and mouth</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	Don face shield	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure proper fit</li> <li>• Foam head band should sit just above your eyebrows</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	6	Don gloves	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gloves should go over the gown sleeves</li> <li>• Ensure that there is no skin exposure between gown and gloves. If so, extended cuff gloves can be used.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	7	Safety Check	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check for rips/tears and any integrity issues with PPE</li> <li>• Check that all PPE is donned</li> </ul>
