Radiopharmaceutical Prescriptions

All PET subjects must have a valid radiopharmaceutical prescription for each PET study.

- 1. Prescription requests should be submitted electronically to <u>Dr. Mazziotta's</u> email, cc'ing <u>Mary Susselman</u>.
 - Except for Fallypride Fallypride scripts should be written by Dr. Mandelkern and shown to the CNMT on the scan day.
- 2. Submissions must include:
 - o A completed signature page of the consent form (not the whole consent)
 - o A physical exam form, including vitals
 - o A prepared prescription template which includes:
 - Type of radiopharmaceutical
 - Amount (in mCi)
 - Route of administration
 - # of injections
 - IRB protocol #
 - Subject's full name
 - Age
 - Scan date
- 3. An example of an email request can be found below.
- 4. The PET Neuro Exam Form and Prescription Template can be found in the <u>documents</u> section. You may also use your own exam template if you prefer. Vitals are required, no exceptions.
- 5. Once Dr. Mazziotta approves the prescription you will receive a printed copy of the signed prescription. The printed copy can be picked up from CNMT on the PET scan day.
- 6. If Dr. Mazziotta does not reply all, please make sure you forward <u>Mary Susselman</u> a copy of the approval email.
- 7. All prescriptions MUST be signed prior to the PET scan. Please submit prescriptions 3 days prior to your scan to give Dr. Mazziotta sufficient time to review and sign it.
- 8. Prescriptions and consent forms will be reviewed prior to the PET acquisition. If any documentation is missing the scan will be cancelled.
